DIVISIONS: GRADES 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, AND 8.

TEAM MEMBERS: Teams shall consist of three to four players with at least one boy and one girl on each team. One girl must play at all times during the games. Younger players may play up one grade but older players cannot play down. Players must play up if they are more than one year older than the kids in their grade.

A PLAYER MAY ONLY PLAY ON ONE TEAM!

COACHES: Each team must have one or two responsible adults for contact by tournament organizers. At least one coach must attend the tournament and coach/monitor their team during games.

FORMAT: Either two and out or a round robin with two teams advancing to the finals. (Format depends on the number of teams registered) Finals are one game only even for round robin divisions.

COST: 40.00 PER TEAM

PRIZES: Medals will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place.

RULES: Will be posted at tournament. Similar to past years and other 3v3 tournaments.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Youth Liability releases must be completed by Parents/Guardians before players will be allowed on the court.

YOUTH 3 ON 3 COED BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT RULES

GENERAL RULES:

1. Teams shall consist of three to four players with at least one boy and one girl on each team. One girl must play at all times during games. Younger players may play up one grade but older players may not play down. Players must play up if they are more than one year older than the kids in their grade.
2. **All players may only play on one team.**
3. Each team must have a coach present at all times.
4. All players shall sign a Release of Liability prior to beginning play. All players who fail to sign the Release shall be deemed to have knowledge of these Rules and shall be deemed to have executed the release available at the tournament and shall be deemed to have released the Bethel-Tate Schools, its coaches and Bethel Youth Basketball and its coaches and parents, sponsors, officers, officials, volunteers, agents and representatives from any and all liability for injury or other claims that may arise from each player's participation in the 3 on 3 tournament.
5. **Poor sportsmanship shall be grounds for forfeiting of any game and/or ejection of teams or players from a game or the tournament. Arguing with a referee shall be grounds for ejection. Only coaches should communicate with referees.**
6. Any dispute concerning any matter in relation to the tournament shall be decided promptly by a majority of the Tournament Organizers available. All decisions by Tournament Organizers shall be final. There are no protests beyond the resolution just described.
7. Tournament Organizers reserve the right to make such changes to these rules as may be necessary in order to run the tournament in a timely and orderly fashion, including but not limited to lowering the Winning Score set forth below.
8. It is the responsibility of each team to be ready to start each game at the game time. It is the responsibility of each team to determine when its next game will be played. Each team will be allotted a five minute grace period. After five minutes, the team failing to appear shall be subject to forfeiture. The game may be postponed or the grace period extended at the discretion of Tournament Organizers.
9. Warm ups will be as time allows but may be limited to three minutes.

RULES OF PLAY:

1. Scoring: 2 points for shots inside the 3 point line, 3 points for shots outside the 3 point line, 1 point for free throws. Each team is responsible for having someone assist with scoring to make sure the score is accurate and to tally team fouls. The referee is not responsible for the score.
2. Free throws: two shots on all shooting fouls inside the 3 point line, three shots for fouls outside of the 3 point line, 1 & 1 bonus on the fifth team foul and all subsequent fouls, two shots for any technical foul on a player or a coach.
3. Winning Score:
 - 3rd grade: 9 points
 - 4th grade: 13 points
 - 5th grade: 17 points
 - 6th grade: 21 points
 - 7th grade: 21 points
 - 8th grade: 21 points
4. **Winning teams must win by 2 points or the first team to:**
 - 3rd grade: 12 points
 - 4th grade: 16 points
 - 5th grade: 21 points
 - 6th grade: 25 points
 - 7th grade: 25 points
 - 8th grade: 25 points

Once the game continues past the first amount needed to win and there is not a 2 point advantage at that time (ie: 21-20) then the game proceeds to the new amount needed to win (ie: 25), regardless whether either team takes a lead by 2 points.

5. Clearing point for change of possession: On each change of possession the ball must be taken or caught by a player with both feet past the 3 point line.
6. Over and Back: There is no over and back.
7. Boundaries: Boundaries will be determined prior to the start of each game and may be changed at the discretion of the Tournament Organizers, except that the boundaries may not be changed once the first point in a game has been scored. The top, sides and bottom of the backboard are inbounds and playable.
8. First possession: Possession to start the game will be determined by a coin toss. The team winning the coin toss is awarded the ball.
9. Start of possession: Any inbound situation, the start of game and start of play after a made basket shall be at the top of the key behind the 3 point line. Prior to putting the ball in play, the offensive player shall “check the ball” with the defense.
10. Possession after score: The ball shall change possession after any made basket or second or third free throw.
11. Jump Ball: Possession after a jump ball is awarded to the defense.
12. Time outs: Each team is awarded 2 time outs per game. Each time out is 1 minute.
13. Substitutions: Players may be substituted at any dead ball situation.
